Possible B2 answers: Notice how each response gives a clear idea and support.

1. What annoys you most in daily life? Why?

Example: What frustrates me most is when people play videos aloud on public transport. It creates unnecessary noise in a shared space.

2. Do bad manners annoy you? In which situations?

Example: Yes. I find it irritating when people interrupt, arrive late without apologising, or leave a mess for someone else.

3. What do your parents or family members do that annoys you most?

Example: My family sometimes asks me to fix technical problems immediately, even when I am busy.

4. What do children do that you find most annoying?

Example: I find it difficult when children scream for a long time in public places, although I understand that they are still learning self-control.

5. Describe the most annoying person you know.

Example: The most annoying person I know is not deliberately rude, but they dominate conversations and rarely listen to anyone else.

6. Have you ever experienced road rage?

Example: Yes. I once saw two drivers argue after one of them cut in front of the other. The situation escalated because neither person was willing to calm down.

7. What annoying habits do people have? Make a list.

Example: People often interrupt, complain without offering solutions, use phones during conversations, and fail to clean up after themselves.

8. Have you lost your temper recently? What happened?

Example: I lost my temper when a delivery arrived several days late and customer service could not explain why. I regretted speaking too sharply afterwards.
