1. How often do you watch TV?

Example: I watch TV two or three times a week.

2. What kind of programmes do you usually watch?

Example: I usually watch documentaries and comedy programmes.

3. Are there any shows that you dislike?

Example: I dislike reality shows because they feel repetitive.

4. Do you like cartoons? Which ones do you like?

Example: Yes, I like animated films, especially funny ones.

5. Do you watch the news? Which channel or source do you use?

Example: I watch the news online in the morning.

6. Who is one of your favourite TV personalities?

Example: One of my favourite presenters is calm and asks good questions.

7. Who is your favourite comedian?

Example: My favourite comedian tells stories about everyday life.

8. What is a commercial that you really like?

Example: I like adverts that are short, funny and memorable.

9. What is the most popular show at the moment?

Example: A popular show at the moment is a drama that many people discuss online.

10. What did you watch yesterday?

Example: Yesterday I watched a travel programme.

11. How big is your TV? Why did you buy it?

Example: My TV is medium-sized, and I bought it for watching films.

12. Which is better: movies or TV shows?

Example: I think TV shows are better because the stories can develop slowly.
