Example: My biggest fear is losing my passport.

7. Where was your secondary-school trip?

Example: Our school trip was to a coastal town.

8. Where is the best place you have ever been?

Example: The best place I have been is a small island with clear water.

9. Which place in your country would you most recommend to visitors?

Example: I would recommend the old part of my city because it has good food and history.

10. Where are you planning to go next?

Example: Next, I am planning to visit my cousin in another city.

11. What is a cheap way to travel where you live?

Example: Taking a coach or train early is often the cheapest way.

12. Where is the best country in the world for tourists to visit?

Example: There is no best country, but I think places with friendly people and good transport are great for visitors.
