Example: I usually read at home before bed.

Example: My favourite writer creates interesting characters and simple, clear stories.

Example: The best book I have read was a novel that made me see life differently.

6. Are you reading any books now?

Example: Yes, I am reading a short mystery novel now.

7. What was your favourite book when you were a child?

Example: My favourite childhood book was about a young wizard.

8. Do you read comics? What is your favourite?

Example: Yes, I enjoy comics with funny pictures and short stories.

9. If you wanted to write a book, what kind of book would you write?

Example: I would write a travel story about two friends on a long train journey.

10. How often do you read the newspaper?

Example: I read online news almost every day.

11. Is reading good for you? Why?

Example: Yes, reading improves vocabulary and helps people understand other ideas.

Example: Yes, I have read short stories and news articles in English.
