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Possible B2 answers: Notice how each response gives a clear idea and support.

1. What things is France famous for?

Example: France is famous for its food, art, fashion, literature and historical influence. It is also known for regional variety, which is often overlooked in simple descriptions.

2. What images do people often have of French culture?

Example: People often associate French culture with cafés, fashion and strong opinions about food. These images can be interesting, but they do not describe every individual.

3. Is Paris the most romantic city in the world? Why or why not?

Example: Paris can feel romantic because of its architecture, parks and cultural associations. However, romance depends more on a person's experience than on a city's reputation.

4. What might French people be proud of?

Example: People may be proud of France's artistic heritage, scientific achievements and public institutions. Pride can be positive when it does not become disrespectful towards others.

5. Which living French people do you know, and why are they famous?

Example: I know several French writers, athletes and film-makers whose work has reached an international audience. Their fame usually comes from a particular achievement rather than nationality alone.

6. Which stereotypes about France should people question?

Example: People should question stereotypes that suggest everyone in a country behaves or thinks in the same way. They can be entertaining, but they often hide real diversity.

7. Who is an important French person in history?

Example: Marie Curie is an important figure because of her scientific work and the barriers she overcame. Her legacy has influenced medicine and research around the world.

8. Would you like to visit France? Why or why not?

Example: I would like to visit France to experience its museums, regional food and everyday life outside the most famous tourist areas.
