2. get drunk	become affected by drinking too much alcohol	A guest got drunk and behaved rudely at the party.
3. get angry	become annoyed or upset about something	She got angry when nobody took her complaint seriously.
4. get involved in	take an active part in something	He got involved in a project to improve the local park.
5. get permission to	be allowed to do something	We got permission to use the hall for our event.
6. get the impression that	form an idea or feeling about a situation	I got the impression that the interviewer liked my ideas.
7. get a chance to	have an opportunity to do something	I finally got a chance to speak to the organiser.
8. get better at	improve your ability to do something	I'm getting better at explaining complicated ideas.
