2. look at	move your eyes towards something	Look at the picture on page two.
3. listen to	give attention to a sound or a speaker	We listen to the teacher.
4. write down	write something so you can remember it	I write down new words.
5. read aloud	read so other people can hear you	We read the short story aloud.
6. work in pairs	work with one other person	We work in pairs to ask questions.
7. take turns	do something one person after another	We take turns reading the questions.
8. say it again	repeat the same words	Please say it again, slowly.
