1. get on	enter a bus, train or plane	I get on the bus near my home.
2. get off	leave a bus, train or plane	We get off the train in the city centre.
3. go straight on	continue forward without turning	Go straight on past the bank.
4. turn left	go towards the left	Turn left at the traffic lights.
5. turn right	go towards the right	Turn right after the supermarket.
6. on foot	by walking	I go to school on foot.
7. by bus	using a bus to travel	We go to the station by bus.
8. over there	in that place, away from you	The bus stop is over there.
