USEFUL LANGUAGE

1. Nice to meet you.	a greeting when you meet someone for the first time	Hi, I'm Anna. Nice to meet you.
2. How are you?	a question about how someone feels	Hello, Sam. How are you today?
3. Where are you from?	a question about someone's home country or town	I'm from Lima. Where are you from?
4. See you later.	a friendly way to say goodbye	I must go now. See you later.
5. Have a nice day.	a friendly wish for someone's day	Goodbye, and have a nice day.
6. You're welcome.	a polite answer to thank you	Thank you for your help. You're welcome.
7. Excuse me.	polite words to get someone's attention	Excuse me. Is this seat free?
8. No problem.	a friendly way to say you can help or accept an apology	Can you help me? Yes, no problem.
