2. come along	go somewhere with another person or group	We're going to the park. Would you like to come along?
3. find out	learn information you did not know before	I need to find out when the museum opens.
4. call back	phone someone who phoned you earlier	I'm busy now, but I'll call you back tonight.
5. at the moment	now or during the present period	I'm studying for an exam at the moment.
6. in a hurry	needing to do something quickly	We can't stop for coffee; we're in a hurry.
7. on time	at the planned time, without being late	The train arrived on time.
8. from now on	starting now and continuing into the future	From now on, I'll check my bag before leaving.
