4. get back	return to a place	We got back from the beach at six.
5. get around	travel from place to place in an area	It's easy to get around the town by bus.
6. on the way	during a journey to somewhere	We bought water on the way to the station.
7. have a look	look at something for a short time	Let's have a look at the map.
8. take your time	do something without hurrying	Take your time; our train leaves in an hour.
