1. look forward to	feel happy about something that will happen	I am looking forward to visiting my cousins.
2. put off	delay something until a later time	We put off the picnic because of the rain.
3. turn up	arrive or appear	Only six people turned up for the walk.
4. end up	finally reach a place or situation, often unexpectedly	We missed the train and ended up taking a bus.
5. make up your mind	decide what you want to do	I cannot make up my mind about the course.
6. give it a go	try something, even if you are unsure	I have never danced salsa, but I will give it a go.
7. just in case	because something might happen	Take a jacket just in case it gets cold.
8. be up to someone	be someone's responsibility to decide	We can eat here or go out; it is up to you.
